
Juvenile Defense Attorney

What is Juvenile Criminal Law?

- Juvenile crime law deals with under-age individuals, who are treated very differently than adults in criminal law, and usually have their own courts of law.
- In Connecticut, New York, and North Carolina, a juvenile is a person under the age of 16.

- This may involve monitoring and enforcing the rules set down by the judge and social worker, attending family counseling sessions, or taking part in Parent Education classes to help you better deal with your child.
